1. INTRODUCTION

Purpose.

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to describe how Huntington Medical Research Institutes, (“HMRI”) collects, uses and shares information about you through our online interfaces (e.g., websites and mobile applications) owned and controlled by us, including www.hmri.org (collectively referred to herein as the “Site”). 2. INFORMATION THAT WE COLLECT

Information You Provide to Us

We collect information you provide to us, for example when you donate, create or modify your account, register to use our Site, request information from us or otherwise communicate with us. This information may include:

- Company Name
- Contact Name
- Contact Address
- Email address
- Telephone number

- Credit card and bank account number (solely for donation purposes – we do not store credit card information?)
- User generated content
Social Media Accounts
- Event Registration

Information We Collect Through Your Use of our Site

Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. (“Google”) to collect certain information relating to your use of the Site. Google Analytics uses “cookies”, which are text files placed on your computer, to help the Site analyze user activity on the Site. We may also use Google Analytics Advertising Features or other advertising networks to provide you with interest-based advertising based on your online activity. Information Collected Through Cookies and Similar Technologies

Our vendors may use cookies to receive and store certain types of information whenever you interact with our Site through your computer or mobile device. A cookie is a small file containing a string of characters that is sent to your computer when you visit a website. When you visit the Site again, the cookie allows the Site to recognize your browser. Cookies may store unique identifiers, user preferences and other information. You can reset your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some Site features or services may not function properly without cookies. We use cookies to improve the quality of our service, including for storing user preferences, and tracking user trends.

No Information from Children Under Age 13

If you are under 13, do not register with us at this Site or provide any personal information about yourself. If we learn we have collected personal information from a child under 13, we will promptly delete it. 3. HOW WE USE AND SHARE YOUR INFORMATION

- Dealing with, and responding to you about, a comment you have submitted for or on our social media accounts, message boards, blogs and other such user generated content facilities.

Sharing with Third Parties.

We may provide information to third party service providers, such as “Classy” that help us operate and manage our Site and process donations and a third-party CRM provider to manage our constituent data and operate marketing campaigns. These service providers will have access to your personal information to provide these services, but when this occurs, we implement reasonable contractual and technical protections to limit their use of that information to help us process the donations.

Your Consent.

In addition to the sharing described data elsewhere in this Policy, we will share personal information with companies, organizations, or individuals outside of HMRI when we have your consent to do so.

Legal Proceedings.

We will share personal information with third party companies, organizations, or individuals outside of HMRI if we have a good-faith belief that access, use, preservation or disclosure of the information is necessary to:

- Meet any applicable law, regulation, subpoena, legal process, or enforceable governmental request.
- Enforce applicable Terms of Use, including investigation of potential violations.
- Detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security, or technical issues.
- Protect against harm to the rights, property, or safety of HMRI, our users, customers or the public as required or permitted by law.

Transfer in the Event of Sale or Change of Control.

If the ownership of all or substantially all of our business changes or we otherwise transfer assets relating to our organization, the Site may be transferred to a third party, and in

conjunction, we may transfer or sell your personal information to the new owner. In such a case, unless permitted otherwise by applicable law, your information would remain subject to the promises made in the applicable privacy policy.

There is no guarantee that information may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed by breach of any of our physical, technical, or managerial safeguards. It is your responsibility to protect the security of your login information. Please note that e-mails and other communications you send to us through our Site are not encrypted, and we strongly advise you not to communicate any confidential information through these means.

We will update this privacy policy when necessary to reflect feedback, changes in our programs/projects and services or legal changes. We will not reduce your rights under this Privacy Policy without your consent in accordance with applicable law. We will also keep prior versions of this Privacy Policy in an archive for your review.
